## TUITION

Please check one option:

**Option 1: Early Enrollment \$2000 (\$2059 on Square)**

At the time of applying, please submit the registration form, a reference letter, a short self-taped monologue or song, and a non-refundable deposit of \$400 (**\$411.90 on Square**) by **December 1, 2022**. \* If accepted, students will be invoiced to pay a non-refundable housing deposit of \$600 (**\$617.70 on Square**) within 2 weeks of acceptance. The additional \$1600 (**\$1647 on Square**) non-refundable tuition balance must be paid by February 15, 2023. If the balance is unpaid at this time, the student will be liable to the standard tuition rate. Additional housing balances will be invoiced separately and are based on occupancy choices. *\*ITDP will only refund tuition payments if a student is not accepted to the program.*

**Option 2: Standard Enrollment \$2200 (\$2264 on Square)**

If applying **after December 1, 2022**, at the time of applying please submit the registration form, reference letter, a short self-taped monologue or song, and a non-refundable deposit of \$400 (**\$411.90 on Square**). \* If accepted, students will be invoiced to pay a non-refundable housing deposit of \$600 (**\$617.70 on Square**) within 2 weeks of acceptance. The additional \$1800 (**\$1853 on Square**) non-refundable balance must be paid by February 15, 2023. If the balance is unpaid at this time, the student may forfeit enrollment. Additional housing deposits and balances will be invoiced separately and are based on occupancy choices. *\*ITDP will only refund tuition payments if a student is not accepted to the program.*

**Option 3: Returning Students \$1800 (\$1853 on Square)**

## PAYMENT

Full non-refundable deposit must accompany this application. The applicant agrees to pay all fees under the conditions of this application. Registration fees and tuition fees, paid or outstanding, are non-refundable after dates outlined on individual tuition plan details, even in the event of absence, withdrawal, or dismissal from the program. Tuition must be paid in full before the student can receive a place in the program. If students wish to withdraw from the program at a later date, they may do so but shall receive no reimbursement.

Tuition Covers all seminar classes Zakynthos, Greece, as well as orientation/farewell dinners, Acropolis Tour and Tickets, Traditional Greek Dancing and Ancient Greek Theatre Workshops in Athens, Metro tickets to class studio trip and ticket to the Ancient Theatre at Epidaurus, and bus to Kyllini Port. ## BEHAVIOR
